- Paper, envelopes, stamps, pen/pencil for writing letters
- Sports equipment (optional)
- Camera
- Medication- give to Camp Nurse on arrival

DO NOT BRING:

- *food, candy, pop, money, video games, TVs, Walkmans, radios, CD's, cellular phones, pagers, expensive clothing, knives, hatchets, lighters, or cigarettes, 2 piece bathing suits.*
- *Any clothing, books/magazines of a violent, profane and/or pornographic nature*
